

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

# Editorial





# Cars'92 - The Party

Well... (this is the easiest way to start a report), this should not be the usual kind of party report, where people are going to write about released stuff, presented guys and that stuff. Take it as a kind of personal review (of course: MY view) of a long trip to Denmark. I'll not start with the party and I'll not end with it... I hope you're going to enjoy it...

As it was my first "big" party I can't judge about it. I can only try to describe my experiences with it. Nevertheless:

It was on a rather cold saturday morning when I got up and caught the things which I wanted to take with me. I forgot nothing... I thought. Later on I recognized that I had no socks with me... At about 12 o'clock (am ofcoz) Nothingface/Clique/(and what ever) arrived in the famous south of Hessen (you know: Grafenhausen). Sometimes we thought that he died already (maybe bcos we spoke german?!). At about 10 o'clock (pm) we arrived in Bad Salzungen-Knetterheide (very very strange name for a town!) to visit JTF/Sunrise. He was -normally- expected to drive with PJ Dynamix and Brix (both Comic Pirates) together with us (in a second car, Stupid!) to denmark... but things went another way! We had no



problems to find his house. But I think we arrived at a very bad time. He just had a visit of his girlie and well, ehm We were very sorry! At that time I was already tired like hell (12 hours awake) And still 600 km's to go. Buah Do you know "Meister Pils"?? No? Well, Ans knows it better now. JTF offered beer to us (What did you expect from a Sunriser), but as I neither drink nor smoke I refused - of course! The others drank... also Ans... he had already two tins of Licher...! Well time passed. He told us that the CP-dudes decided NOT to drive together with us but at 5am on Sunday... So we left him (Iam) to get to the danish border. He got rid of the "Meister Pils" he drank and we could start off... Well, I don't know how long we needed as I fell asleep from time to time (Noface & Argos drove). Short before the border we filled up fuel for the last time and Argos noticed that he forgot the lid for the fuel somewhere in S'Uflen... well, we drove without it! The danish border. Normally they don't control cars, we THOUGHT. But things went in another way. As Smile is from turkiye he had to get a VISA to enter germany and he should have got one to enter denmark. He -ofcoz- hasn't got one for denmark. The fuckin' danish cop controlled us and Smile was not allowed to enter DK. We had a problem. So we got back to Flensburg to search for another checkpoint. This time I was forced to drive (it may sound a bit arrogant (the following I mean), but it this is how it was). At this border we got also controlled... We arrived at the "Messe Centre" and got out. At first I was dissappointed! The Party Place wasn't very huge. I mean, it was big enough (at least too big I think) but I expected something like the "Messe Centre" in Frankfurt. I think only the "Festhalle Frankfurt" has the double size!! Nevertheless We entered at hall 2 and got showed to the reception. A looong line of guys stood in front... We needed 'bout one hour until we could pay (120 dkr which is about 35-DM or 24 US\$) (Short note. At lot of guys are so fuckin' proud that they didn't pay... well, if all guys would act like you, there will not be another party!). During this hour we met already some dudes like Dense/RSI (who spreaded Bullet Proof at the party) + more RSI-members, Bulldog/Padua and whoever. It was very funny when Smile had to pay. Every guy had to tell his name+group AND country (to make a list of the presenting dudes)... and Smile came from Türkiye. They hasn't got Türkiye in their computer and the whole system broke down... hehe (they even hasn't got "Belgium"). Afterwards we got our computer stuff and placed it on a table (there weren't any reservations for 64...). After sitting around some minutes Noface, Smile and me got up to walk around and look at the party... Hall 1 was completely occupied by hundreds of Amigas... On every second one they used "X-Copy" and on the others they played games... laaaaame! The PC-section was very (hehe) small. We only saw (about) 5 computers... There weren't as much 64 dudes as I expected (about 200). Maybe my whole expectations were a bit too high, but it was my first party, you know? A lot of tables were empty, but this was because the swedes still didn't arrive (Light had hired a bus and they arrived in the afternoon). Oxyron showed parts of their competition-demo and we were impressed... (later). We walked through the cafeteria and had a look at the prices... In the invitation they wrote that the prices are "cheap"! Well, if this were cheap prices, I don't want to know what a fuckin' burger costed last year!! (30 dkr (=5.2\$) for a "hamburger" (without meat)). Beside the whole stuff was done with

"pig-meat" (pork) and Smile recognized that he would become some serious problems to get something to eat (coz muslims don't eat pig as you should know). Pat/Paralyze tried the Pizza... it was a fault. So we searched outside for something to eat (also Noface hadn't changed money yet (you know, at his place they haven't got danish money... and electric light). In a fuel-station we found something (Smile bought cookies...! The only thing (except chips) without pork). A kind of "imbiss" was placed near to the station and they sold a lot of nice-tasting (!) hot-dogs there...! Good taste, cheap prices (10 dkr). All in all: good! I guess they never had earned that much money before, coz we weren't the only who recognized this imbiss! Getting back to the place we spent the rest of the afternoon by waiting for JTF+Comic Pirates to come. Finally they arrived and JTF brought his 2ltr-fuel-can, filled with cheap wine, with him! You know that ALCOHOL was STRICTLY forbidden at the party place (how stupid! A party without alcohol isn't a party!). Some guys had some serious problems with it... Majesty got caught several times while drinking alcohol and on the second day (better night) they tried to kick him out. It was really funny to see the whole organisation team (10 or 12 dudes) standing around him and discussing with him. Later on they even called the police booz Majesty had a "gas-gun" with him (which isn't forbidden in germany but in denmark)... But nothing happens. I had no problem to get my personal need of alc as we always hid our tins when someone from the organisation walked around (they really tried to control both halls... funny!). I guess it was a shock) and so on... At about 23.00 I got tired like hell (I couldn't keep my eyes open any longer - 4B awake) and Noface and me went to the sleeping hall. We slept the whole night 'til 9.00am. Great! I missed the techno-concert but as I don't like techno anyway it

wasn't a big problem for me. At the morning we got told that JTF took a massive misuse of cheap-wine at the techno concert... Rumours went around that he even couldn't walk anymore? Well, Alc was forbidden as you know! Someone carried him out? No! Unbelievable... (hehehe). At that morning the music-compo 64 took place and we were dissappointed! The music was -mostly- bad! 

**SML:** If you want a real greetinx with it I can fill whole MILESTONE! Only greets to my whole contacts on the world and a special greets to my girlie BERNA...


**MIK:** That's it! I like to thank you for your patience to give this interview! Thanks a lot and see you somewhere. If you want to give some last words, do it! Bye.








the old illegal-mag... what about printing some board numbers and soon coming parties...

# Chaos Communication Congress

(27.-29.12.92)

Title: BLUEBOXING - QUO VADIS

Author: Henne (henne\*mafia.ccc.de)

Sorry to all nongermans but I had no time to translate this report. This text was written by Henne not by me (just as a info).

Andy vom CCC stellte fest, daß die Telekom durch die amerikanische Telefongesellschaft AT&T und einige kleinere Gesellschaften zum Handeln gezwungen wurde nachdem publicity- und Geldgeile Kids sich in der Öffentlichkeit als Bluebox-Experten in diversen Magazinen produziert hatten. Dabei war weniger der finanzielle Schaden für die Telekom relevant sondern eher der Image-Verlust. Die Folge war die Anschaffung teurer Geräte von British Telekom, die einige für die Vermittlungsrechner eigentlich zu kurze C5-Codes erkennen und zurückschicken. Einfache Filter würden nicht helfen, weil sie durch die Erhöhung der Lautstärke bzw. leichte Frequenzschwankungen unwirksam würden und sie auch die normale Sprach und Datenkommunikation stören würden. Diese Vorrichtungen machen den meisten Nur-Anwendern, die einfache PC- bzw. AMIGA-Programme einsetzen das Leben/Telefonieren schwer, für die wahren Phreaks jedoch, die das Technische Verständnis mitbringen sind sie aber keine unüberwindliche Hürde.

Bei digitalen Vermittlungsstellen kamen zusätzlich noch Fangschaltungen bei potentiellen Blueboxern hinzu. Dem CCC sind jedoch keine konkreten Anschuldigungen der Telekom gegenüber einzelnen Personen bekannt. Die Meldungen von Hausdurchsuchungen scheinen Panikmache einer bestimmten Gruppe zu sein. Anzeigen gab es nur gegen einige Anbieter, die kommerziell sogenannte Freephones verkauften, selbst diesen Leuten war jedoch nur mit dem Vorwurf des unlauteren Wettbewerbs beizukommen und nicht mit einer Strafanzeige wegen Erschleichung von Dienstleistungen oder Aufruf zu einer Straftat. Das zeigt die schwache rechtliche Position der Telekom im Bereich Blueboxing! Neben diesen technischen Vorrichtungen droht die Telekom auch mit strafrechtlichem Vorgehen gegen Blueboxer, es ist jedoch fraglich, inwiefern die Aktion beweisbar sind und ob sich der Aufwand für die die Telekom lohnen würde. Rop von Hacktic (Holland) meinte dazu, das diese Unregelmäßigkeiten von der Holländischen Post in der Regel nicht verfolgt werden, weil der Aufwand grösser als der Nutzen sei. Oft sind sie sogar froh darüber, das die Phreaks Sicherheitslöcher im Telefonnetz aufdecken, auch wenn sie meistens nicht in der Lage sind, sie schnell und ausreichend zu stopfen. Ganz anders sehen es die Vertreter der SRI, einer internationalen Vereinigung für Computersicherheit mit engen Verbindungen zu CIA, NSA usw. Die Leiter der SRI (Parker/USA und Lindup/GB) haben bereits Kontakte zur holländischen und deutschen Blueboxer-Szene aufgenommen um abzuklopfen, ob sich hier ein sicherheitsrelevanter Bereich auf tut, der entsprechend kommerziell abgedeckt werden kann um die Sicherheit des Welttelefonnetzes auch in

Zukunft durch neue Technik bzw. neue Gesetze garantieren zu können.

In Zukunft werden die Phreaks sich vermehrt mit den C7-Codes und digitalen Ortsvermittlungsstellen beschäftigen, bei denen Sprech- und Zeichengabekanal getrennt sind. Dies wird zwar noch schwieriger, bietet aber auch mehr interessante Möglichkeiten.

Charts: Yuh. The first original idea. The only chart is the top 100 (!) swapper-chart. I think a cool idea!

Interview. The usual questions to TTS/Oxyron (beside: Did you notice that TTS gets interviewed by every mag nowadays??). Nothing special.

Mixed: There are some memberstatus, slogans about groups and a few BBS-Numbers.

Last words: Just some lyrics if the 64'er Scene will survive the next years.

Comment: Nothing special in the world of Disc-Mags. A big disadvantage is the very less text and that there are no big ideas.

## Internal #17/WoW

Intro: There are better ones. But one of the best i've ever reviewed.

Menue: A normal Internal Logo. And the usual chapter-choose-menue. At the end of the menue you can choose between 8 musics. Very comfortable I think. Not every mag got it. You can choose between following chapters:

Editorial 17: A Editorial with 68 pages. Very hard to remember. Just this: "I don't wanna Internal to be reviewed!". Hm, o.k., but ALL mags need support. That means e.g. critic. Or am I wrong??

Editorial 17 Part 2: Again lot of text. To keep it short: A lot of crap about the scene and about himself. Very funny to read!!

Elite Jaw: A fucking interesting text about so-called Elite guys. It's shit to repeat the text here, 'cause everyone should have his own opinion about this.

News: a looot of news (like in all mags!)

Magazine Review: I think he reviewed nearly all(!) diskmag. Except the best Milestone (hehe). The same problem as everywhere: How can a DISKmag editor be objective by reviewing a kind of concurrence-mag?

Mega-Charts: Mega-Charts have a disadvantage: it's boring to print groups with one point. But there is a advantage. You can see if someone

Mixmania: Three Sexstoriys. I think it's for unsatisfiesfield people. Or??

Mixmania 2: Three cinema reviews and a list of the belgian scene dudes. Internal wants to print those lists of every country. Quite impossible I think and who is interested in such a list anyway? Maybe in the total amount of sceners but not in every single name!

Addresses 1+2: Like in all mags....

Ed's we love: A little attack against the Accuracy mag 'Splash' 'cause they tested Internal unobjotive (in WoW's opinion!).

The Scene: Some lyrics about the old 'n' young Scene generation. It's all his opinion!

Meetings: Infos about the monthly WoW-Meeting. And last but not least some crap about WoW.

Friendship: Puh, again his opinion about the friendship and how important it is.

Games: His lyrics if the game-companies will ever release games on the go(ol) old 64'er.

Comment: Internal is surely a top ten mag. But of course some critical points: It's very interesting to read a opinion about some themes. To less mags do it. But nealy 10 chapters full of opinions. That very much and at the end very hard to read. Maybe they should drop some chapters. But that was the only critical point.

## Higher Postage

Well... I think that the following changed already, beoz Germany's old minister got kicked out and the new one changed everything concerning this. Nevertheless, "Postdienst!" will increase the postage, the question is the date... And it will not only be a change of the price... No! Everything will be changed! For example "Drucksache" will not be possible any longer! And all other ways of sending ("Büchersendung", "Warensendung" etc.) will be increased very hard! And, well, the whole old system will be skipped! There will be four classes of postage. Up to 20g; 20-50g, 50-500g and 500-1000g. For example a normal letter (235\*125mm/20g) will still cost 1.- DM. But if you want to send out two disks as a letter (to get it more faster), it will not cost 2,40 like in former times, but 3.- DM! And "Warensendung" will be divided into several sizes! A normal 5,25" disk costs 2,50 DM as a Warensendung (MORE than a letter!). This is more than the double price (1.-DM now). "Büchersendung" will be 1,10 DM (instead of 0,60) and over 50g(!) it will be 1,50DM! This is also more than the double price (remember: 0,60 'til 100g!). If this increasement really gets reality, it will be very hard for germans to keep a lot of contacts! The end of mail-trade in Germany? At least for 5,25' format I think! You still can send out a 3,5' disk for 1.- DM. But with 5,25' it's impossible... Be prepared!

Ed (08/93): As you know the fuckin' Postdienst did all this, which stands above. Double prices, new postcodes and this bloody Postdienst is slower than at the beginning of this year. I wish them the worst!




